

## Cervical Cancer Screening Codes For HEDIS

Blue Cross Blue Shield of Wyoming is required to track quality in accordance with HEDIS guidelines. We request you submit the following codes for women screened for cervical cancer using any of the following criteria:

- Women 21–64 years of age who had cervical cytology performed within the last three years.
- Women 30–64 years of age who had cervical high-risk human papillomavirus (HPV) testing performed within the last 5 years.
- Women 30–64 years of age who had cervical cytology/high-risk human papillomavirus (HPV) co-testing within the last 5 years.

Those excluded are women who have had a hysterectomy with no residual cervix (complete, total, or radical abdominal or vaginal hysterectomy), cervical agenesis, or acquired absence of cervix any time during the member's history through Dec. 31 of the measurement year.

## EXCLUSIONS AND EXEMPTIONS FOR HEDIS

**Exclusions-** Hospice, palliative care, Advanced illness, Frailty, and long-term care nursing home resident. Each measure has its own specific exclusions.

**Advanced illness-** late-stage chronic illness, when one or more conditions become serious enough that general health and function decline and treatments begin to lose their impact. (a state that progresses to end of life). Legal definition-Medical or surgical condition with significant functional impairment that is not reversible by curative therapies

**Examples of Advanced illness-** Alzheimer's disease, dementia, chronic kidney disease, heart failure, and malignant conditions.

**Examples of frailty-** reduced mobility, ulcers, history of falls, use of skilled or assisted care, and need for medical equipment (w/c, hospital beds, portable oxygen).
